KAMOL RODKLAI : AN ANALYSIS OF THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SECTORS IN BANGKOK METROPOLIS.  
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The purpose of this study was three-fold: (1) to analyze the current situation of the elementary education management system; (2) to identify the crucial problems of the management system; and (3) to propose guidelines to develop the efficient management system for government and private sectors in Bangkok Metropolis.

This study focused on holistic studies and quantitative techniques were used to analyze the data. An input - output model was utilized. Simply stated, this system theory indicated that inputs go through a process to become outputs. The effect of external environment and other organizational factors (process) on the outputs of student achievement, teacher satisfaction, administrator satisfaction, and resource allocation was determined.

Implications of these and other results were presented in terms of guidelines to develop the efficient management system for government and private sectors in Bangkok Metropolis. Ideas for future research were also discussed.
