This study aimed at investigating the needs of different institutions for personnel with a doctoral degree in nonformal education.

It was found that 78 different institutions, namely government offices, public universities in charge of the ministry of university affairs, state enterprises and non-government organizations, expected themselves to have a need for doctoral degree graduates in nonformal education to work in their organizations between 1992 and 1996. These doctoral graduates would be most needed in 3 fields comprising research and evaluation, personnel development training and seminar, and administration and planning.

Similar numbers of doctoral graduates were found needed for the following jobs; project administration and co-ordination, curriculum development and teaching, social and community development and social welfare, educational media and technology.

The institutions in this study showed their lowest needs for personnel with a doctoral degree in nonformal education in monitoring and supervision.
