

The main objective of this research was to study people's expectation for the judiciary system to punish the violators of the election laws.

Quantitative data were collected from 400 people in Chiang Mai Province through the use of close-ended questionnaires. Statistical analysis involved percentage and mean.

The findings showed that:

The people had a high expectation for the judiciary system to harshly punish the violators, which was relevant to the hypothesis. The punishments included, revoking the voting rights, losing all the rights specified in the constitution, and imprisonment
