Abstract

The purpose of this research were to study about the intention of nurses in complying with Universal Precautions, and the relationship between intention with behavior of nurses complying with Universal Precautions. Sample were 280 nurses in community hospitals, Chiang Mai province. The data were collected by questionnaires. The data were analysed by frequency distribution, percentage, standard deviation, arithmetic means and relationship were tested by Pearson's correlation coefficient.

The results of the study showed that

- 1. Nurses had excellent intention in complying with Universal Precautions
- 2. There were significance correlation between attitude toward to behavior, subjective norm and perceived behavioral control with intention of nurses in complying with Universal Precautions at level of .01
- 3. There were significance correlation between intention of nurses in complying with Universal Precautions and behavior complying with Universal Precautions at the level of .01
