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ABSTRACT

The objective of this research was to study the status and problems concerning internet utilization in studying of students at Vocational Diploma level 2 in technical college at Bangkok zone under Vocational Diploma, Ministry of Education. The sample which consisted of 361 students at Vocational Diploma level 2 had been selected through the stratified random sampling. The tool was the questionnaire which was comprised of choices and a scale for assessing. The statistical methods that had been used to analyze the data were percentage, means, standard deviation, correlation, and one way ANOVA.

The results were that conditions of computer, software, and provided communication system were sometimes unavailable. Most students who used the World Wide Web research had much needs and problems of internet utilization in studying. Furthermore, the comparison of students needs and problems of internet utilization in studying among students from different technical colleges showed that students from Don-Meung Technical College, Dusit Technical College, and Golden Jubilee Maha-Nakorn College were significantly different needs in internet utilization both in studying and after class at the level 0.5.
