The Purpose of this experimental research was to study the Effects of group activities to desirable attitudes towards addictive drugs to matayomsuksa 2 students. The subjects were chosen from the lowest score running in the desirable attitudes towards addictive drugs questionnaire. The subject were devided into two groups, fifteen for experimental group, fifteen for control group. The experimental group was treated with the 12 programs of group activities, meeting twice a week for 50 minutes each meeting, however the control group received no activities program.

After experiment, both group were post test using the same the attitudes towards addictive drugs questionnaire, t-test was utilized for analysis of the data.

The result indicated that:

- 1. After the experiment, the students attending group activities were significantly higher in desirable attitudes towards addictive drugs than before the experiment at the level of .01
- 2. No significant difference was found between the experimental and the control group.
