The purpose of this research was to study the effects of group work to vocational choosing behavior of Mattayom Suksa 3 students' in Education Opportunity Expanding Schools under the office of Provincial primary education in Phihit

The subjects were 48 students in Padang School. Tapanhin District, Pichit Province, during the second semester of the 1999 academic year. They were divided into two groups, of 24 students: an experimental group and 24 students: a control group. The experimental group was treated by group process according to program that the researcher had made. The researcher provided the advice for the group which met 2 times a week for 50 minutes each time for period of 6 weeks. Totaling 12 times. The control group studied in regular class. The research design was the randomized with Pre test-Post test design. The research instrument was the Vocational Attitudes Questionnaire with 30 items which had been prepared by the researcher. It's reliability caefficient was 0.75. The 1 test was used for data analysis.

The result of this study showed that experimental group revealed higher improvement in the Vocational attitudes at the .01 level of significance and significant difference was found between the experimental and the control groups.
