

The Majors Findings

1. There was no relationship between leadership styles and abilities in ward management of head nurses at 0.05 statistical significant level. Therefore the hypothesis was not accepted.
2. The head nurses expressed three leadership styles : democratic, autocratic, and laissez-faire. The score of democratic leadership style was highest.
3. Almost head nurses (98.82 percent) were democratic Leadership Style.
4. There were only two ability levels in ward management of head nurses, the highest level and the middle level. There was no lowest level.
5. All head nurses were democratic leadership style in two ability levels, the difference was at 0.001 statistical significant level. That was the abilities in ward management did not concern with the leadership styles of head nurses.
