






ABSTRACT

This research is descriptive research. The purposes of this research were : (1) to study the relation between nursing students' relationship and stress as related to professional nurses. (2) To study the levels of nursing students' relationship and stress as related to professional nurses. (3) To compare relationship and stress as perceived by nursing students related to professional nurses classified by nursing departments. The sample were 132 junior nursing students at Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University, in the second semester, 1993.

The questionnaires are relationship' questionnaire which developed by Palladee Unhalakhaka and Health Opinion Survey.

Data were analyzed by using Pearson Product Moment Correlation

Coefficients, One Way Analysis of Variance And analysis of Co-variance.

The results of this Research were :

1. The relationship between nursing students and professional nurses was negative correlation with nursing students' stress at the significant level of 0.05.

2. The relationship between nursing students and professional nurses was at the good level. The nursing students' stress was at the low level.

3. There was no difference on relationship between nursing students and professional nurses by nursing department at the significant level of 0.05.

4. There was no difference in nursing students' stress by nursing department at the significant level of 0.05.
