CHURAIRAT PREAWPRAI : PROBLEMS OF HEALTH EDUCATION TEACHING AND NEEDS FOR SUPERVISION OF HEALTH EDUCATION TEACHERS IN THE PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN BANGKOK METROPOLIS. THESIS ADVISOR : ASSO. PROF. RAJANEE QUANBOONCHAN, 117 pp.

The purposes of this research were to study the problems of teaching health education and needs for supervision of health education teachers in the private secondary schools in Bangkok Metropolis and to compare these problems and needs between the less experienced teachers and the more experienced teachers.

The questionnaires were sent to 121 health education teachers and 110 questionnaires or 90.90 percent were returned. The data were analyzed into percentage, means, standard deviation, and the t-test was also calculated.

Results of the study were as follows :

1. Generally, problems in teaching health education of the health education teachers were in the low level.

2. In general, health education teachers need supervision in the high level especially on these following areas : curriculum and subject matter; qualification of supervision and supervision management.

3. There was no significant difference between the less experienced and the more experienced health education teachers on problem of teaching health education and the need of supervision.
