

PAISIN LANGSANAM, Lt. Cdr. : THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN NURSING ADMINISTRATORS' LEADER BEHAVIOR AND ORGANIZATIONAL CLIMATE OF NURSING INSTITUTES, UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE. THESIS ADVISOR ; ASST. PROF. Dr. WEERAWAT UTAIRAT, Ph.D., 112 pp.

Purpose of the Research : The purposes of this research were to study the nursing administrators' leader behavior, the organizational climate and the relationship between the nursing administrators' leader behavior and organizational climate of nursing institutes under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Defense.

Research Findings :

1. The initiating structure dimension of the leader behavior of every nursing administrator was at medium level.
2. The consideration dimension of the leader behavior of three nursing administrators was at medium level, but the consideration of the Airforce nursing administrator was at high level.
3. The organizational climate of three nursing institutes was consultative, but another one was benevolent autocrat.
4. The initiating structure was related with the organizational climate at medium level with .01 statistical significance and the consideration was related with the organizational climate at high level with .01 statistical significance.
