

Thesis Title The Study of Laws, Rules, and Regulations
 Concerning the Liabilities of the Physical
 Education Teachers

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to study legal rules and regulations governing duties and responsibilities of physical education teachers. The procedures were done by studying and compiling necessary data from civil and commercial code, penal code. legal textbooks, criminal verdicts, periodicals, journals, papers, articles and other publications, Rajapundit dictionary, lectures on laws, and documents covering regulations of the government offices. The interview was also used to get data from qualified legal experts. The data was analyzed and presented in descriptive terms.

It was found that:-

Physical education teachers had to abide by laws as an ordinary citizen normally would have to. But in addition, he also had to bear in his mind and abide by the laws which were directly governing his duty and responsibilities. Some of these laws were found in the Section 420 and Section 430 of the civil and commercial code; and in the penal code governing responsibilities of physical education

teachers as stated in the Section 215, Section 216, Section 265,
Section 295, Section 297, Section 334, Section 362, Section 391, and
Section 393.

These laws were to impose that physical education teachers must
perform their duties and responsibilities with their discretion so that
a negligent act would not occur.
