The purpose of this research was to study a group of variables that could explain and predict teacher potentiality of first year undergraduate students of the faculty of education in Chulalongkorn University, academic year 1986. The research result indicated that variables that could explain and predict each of the fallowing parts of the teacher potentiality were as follow:

1. Specific abilities on observertion, reasoning and language usage: strict child rearing, school being located in Bangkok and responsibility.

Those variables that could explain and predict to total part of the teacher potentiality were: family's economic status, dominance over other, sex and being a resident in Bangkck. ( $R^2 = 8.38 \%$ )
