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The objective of this research were to study the opinions of  
administrators and practitioners of provincial non-formal education centers  
concerning the operation of self-employed development in the northeastern  
region in five aspects. They were 1) surveying and studying data,  
2) preparation for self-employed development, 3) occupational development  
activity, 4) assisting and promoting self-employed, and 5) supervising,  
follow up and evaluating the project. The samples were administrators and  
practitioners of provincial non-formal education in the northeastern region.  
The sample were classified into 2 groups:- The first group was undertaken  
non-formal education for self-employed development and the second group was  
not undertaken such program. The research instrument were questionnaires.  
Data was collected by interview technique; percentage, mean and standard  
deviation were used as statistical tools.

The research results indicated that administrators and practitioners  
agree with the five aspects. The mean of the first group were as follow:  
4.34 4.40 4.36 4.29 and 4.32 and the mean of the second group were 4.34  
4.40 4.31 4.15 and 4.32 respectively.
