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CHANPHEN JIRANONDA : A STUDY OF ALUMNI'S EVALUATIVE OPINIONS
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The purposes of this study were to determine the evaluative opinions of the alumni of Saint Paul de Chartres schools concerning the educational philosophy in the areas of charity, discipline, simplicity and work and to compare those opinions.

The researcher gathered data by using questionnaires and interviewing. The data were analyzed by means of percentage, arithmatic mean, standard deviation, one-way analysis of variance and Duncan's new multiple range test.

The findings of this study were :

1. The alumni's opinions in all schools concerning the educational philosophy in the four areas as a whole, and in the areas of charity and discipline were found to have no statistically significant differences. There were statistically significant differences at the .05 level in the areas of simplicity and work when each school was compared.

2. The alumni's opinions when compared among different age groups and graduation periods were found to have statistically significant differences at the .05 level both in the educational philosophy in the four areas as a whole and in each area.
