The purpose of this research was to study the results of the Vocational Training and Development Centre : Project for Thai People along the Thai-Kampuchean Border Areas in four aspects ; 1) Vocations and Increased Income 2) Attachment to Locality 3) Continuing Education 4) Leadership and Participation in Community Development Activities, and to compare these four aspects between those participants trained according to the full-circle agricultural curriculum and trained according to the short-term vocational curriculum. The instruments utilized in the collection of data were the Likert type questionnaire used with a sample of 577 trainees and the structured interview form used with a sample of 8 Local Leaders.

The important research findings in the four aspects are as follows : -

1. Changes in Vocations and Increased Income were found to be at a low level
2. Changes in Attachment to Locality were found to be in the middle range
3. Changes in Continuing Education were found to be in the middle range
4. Changes in Leadership and Participation in Community Development Activities were found to be in the middle range.

The result of a comparison between the two samples was that the participants who were trained according to the full-circle agricultural curriculum had a significantly higher average score of .05 more than the participants who were trained according to the short-term vocational curriculum.
