

SUPIT PRASOPSIL, Flt.Lt. : A STUDY OF FACTORS SUPPORTING SUPERVISION OF NURSING AS REPORTED BY NURSING SUPERVISORS IN HOSPITALS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE . THESIS ADVISOR : ASST.PROF. PRANOM OTHAGANONT, Ed.D. 162 pp.

The purposes of this study were two folds. They were to study and to compare factor supporting nursing supervision report of nurse supervisor in the Hospitals under the Jurisdiction of the Ministry of Defense.

The major findings:

1. The study revealed that the first factor supporting nursing supervision was the belief in the usefulness of nursing profession. This factor was considered the most supporting. The rest four factors judging much supporting were the nurse supervisor's intuition toward nursing essentially for herself and her family as well as ordinary people, the decision making of skillful nurse supervisor, skillful nurse supervisor's human relationship and workplace telephone communication device.

2. The comparison of factor supporting nursing supervision report of nurse supervisor could be classified in accordance with type and workplace. The results showed that one way communicative administrator was statistically significant difference at .05, with the mean scores of position-nurse supervisor higher than duty-nurse supervisor. Workplace comparison drew the Royal Thai Air Force nurse supervisor higher than the Royal Thai Army nurse supervisor.
