WANIDA CHOKASUTTA: OPINIONS OF INSTRUCTORS AND ENGLISH MAJOR GRADUATES CONCERNING THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE ENGLISH PROGRAM, FACULTY OF HUMANITIES, UNIVERSITY OF THE THAI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE. THESIS ADVISOR: INSTRUCTOR SUJITRA SAWATDIWONG, 131 Pp.

The purpose of this research was to study the opinions of instructors and English major graduates concerning the Bachelor's Degree English program, Faculty of Humanities, University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce in the aspects of curriculum objectives, curriculum structure, subject content, teaching methods and activities, instructional medias, and measurement and evaluation.

It was found that both instructors and graduates thought that the curriculum objectives, curriculum structure, and the subject content were appropriate at the high level. Concerning the measurement and evaluation, both instructors and graduates thought that they were practised at the high level.

Both instructors and graduates agreed that teaching methods and activities were practised at the low level. Concerning instructional medias, the instructors thought that they were practised at the high level but the graduates thought that they were practised at the low level.
