This research study aims to study the actual performance and performance that should be conducted as well as analyze problems of and propose recommendations for the performance of librarians of secondary school clusters under the jurisdiction of the Department of General Education in Bangkok Metropolis.

It was found out from the research study that tasks which librarians of secondary school clusters actually performed at the moderate level include administrative, technical and academic works; whereas those which the librarians performed at the low level are services, activities, public relations, and teaching. Nonetheless, the librarians opined that they should perform all types of functions at the high level.

The study showed that the task which the librarians actually performed and should be performed at the high level with the higher average rate than any other works was the preparation of forms for collecting library statistics.

Problems which the librarians of secondary school clusters encountered at the high level with the highest average rate was the labourious routine work at school. The subsequent problem faced was that the librarians possessed less opportunity to make use of works conducted which was inconsistent with the time spent. Besides, the tasks which the clusters were assigned became the increasing burden to them resulting with the less of time for routine work.
