The purpose of this study was to study a result of teaching by process skill approach in the art for functional living subject in the lower secondary curriculum B.E.252l (revised edition B.E.2533) in schools under the jurisdiction of the Office of Private Education Commission, Bangkok Metropolis.

The samples were 30 Mathayom Suksa Two students of Bangkok Cristian School during the academic year 1993. The research instruments devloped by the researcher were 2 lesson plans ("Art Work Criticism" and" Symbol Design", Paper-Pencil Test, Student-self Evaluation Form, and Learning Achievement Test. The data were analyzed by means of percentage, mean, standard deviation, and t-test.

The results of the study revealed that a result of teaching by process skill approach in the art for functional living subject in the lesson "Art Work Criticism", the students evaluated themselves that they had learned at the moderate level. The teachers evaluated student learning at the very high level. In the lesson "Symbol Design", both students and teachers evaluated students learning at the 'very high level. When comparing the pre-test and post-test scores it was found that there was a stalistically significant difference at the level of .05.
