PROGRAM FOR PRATHOM SUKSA SIX STUDENTS, CHANGWAT RATCHABURI. THESIS
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This study aims to develop career readiness for Prathom Suksa six students in Changwat Ratchaburi by using career-oriented activities. The researcher has developed a career readiness program and invited resource people to evaluate the advantages and the drawbacks of its framework and plan for the activities involve.

This program was then tested on 30 Prathom Suksa six students. The findings of this study can be summarized as follows:

1. The students were well-informed about themselves, their future career and the relationship between themselves and their career decision was higher than the expected level of 80% at significance level of .01
2. The students' career attitude was positively higher at significance level of .01
3. 90% of the students were satisfied with the teaching activities. All of them agreed that the time period set aside for these activities and the teaching media were appropriate. They were convinced of its benefits and eager to participate in such a program again.

These findings have led to the development of a career readiness program for Prathom Suksa six students in Changwat Ratchaburi and served a meaningful purpose of laying the foundation for future vocational education.
