The purpose of this research was to study the state and problems of environmental programs in elementary schools under the jurisdiction of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration in the aspects of the program' objectives, characteristics, operation, personnel, activities, budget resources, results, and problems. The subjects were \mathcal{G} administrators, \mathcal{G} teachers who were responsible for the programs, and $\mathcal{A} \mathcal{G}$ prathom suksa six students. The research instruments consisted of questionnares and observation forms.

The findings were the followings :

There were 56 environmental programs and activities in elementary schools under the jurisdiction of The Bangkok Metropolitan Administrations. Fifteen programs were initiated by the Office of Education, BMA. Twenty seven programs were initiated and \neq or patronized by various Non - Government Organizations. And fourteen programs were initiated within elementary schools.

Environmantal programs initiated by the Office of Education, BMA emphasized awareness concerning environmantal problems. The BMA subsidized all programs. There was time limitation in carrying out activities.

Environmental programs initialed by NGO emphasized practical solutions concerning air pollution, water and waste pollution. Programs and activities were organized, and mostly subsidized by NGO.

Environmental programs initiated by elementary schools emphasized awlareness concerning environmental problems. Activities were conducted in accordance with school curriculum, and subsidized through the school annual budget. Time and financial limitation were the major problems.
