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The objective of this research is to study effects of using instructional packages on "Aids" on students' learning achievement of Prathom Suksa Six students in elementary schools under the jurisdiction of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration. The data were analyzed by means, standard deviation, and t-test method.

Sixty students were randomly selected from Prathom Suksa Six students in Suraothapchang School and Sompotkrunganusorn 200 Years School of the academic year 1992. Thirty students were selected as an experimental group and another thirty students as a controlled group.

The findings were as follows: Efficiencies of instructional packages on "aids" constructed were as follows: 88.00/85.25. The learning achievement after teaching of the experimental group who learned by using packages on "aids" and the controlled group who learned by conventional teaching were significantly higher than learning achievement before teaching at the .01 level. The learning achievement after teaching of the experimental group who learned by using packages on "aids" was significantly higher than learning achievement of the controlled group who learned by conventional teaching at the .01 level.
