

Rattanaporn Siriwong 2012: Participation in Conflict Management in Bophit Sacred Temple, Changwat Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya. Master of Arts (Conflict Management), Major Field: Conflict Management, Faculty of Social Sciences. Thesis Advisor: Miss Oranan Kalantapura, Ph.D. 110 pages.

This study aims were to 1) to study the involvement of the merchants in the temple area, the management of the Bophit. and 2) to compare the level of participation in the management area Bophit sacred temple divided by personal factors.

The studied samples were 187 merchants who trade around the bophit Sacred temple. Questionnaires as well as likert scales were used at tools to conduct the experiment and data collection. Data was analyzed by computer software and implementing statistical methodologies, including percentile, mean , t-test , F-test and LSD at the 0.05 level of significance.

The results of this research indicated that the participation of conflict management in bophit sacred temple was at low level. And also indicated that the different in personality, factors such as gender and birthplace had different in the opinion of the participation level in conflict management at the 0.05 level of significance.
