SUPAWADEE PANASAMPON: OPINIONS OF INSTRUCTORS, GRADUATES AND ENTREPRENEURS CONCERNING TEACHING AND LEARNING IN FURNITURE DESIGN COURSE AT THE HIGHER VOCATIONAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE LEVEL IN THE DEVISION OF FURNITURE MAKING IN RAJAMANGALA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

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The purpose of this research was to study the opinions of instructors, graduates and entrepreneurs concerning teaching and learning in Furniture Design course at the higher vocational education certificate level in the division of Furniture Making in Rajamangala Institute of Technology.

Procedures: The population of the study were 40 instructors, 100 graduates and 60 entrepreneurs. One hundred and sixty-five questionnaires or 74 percents were returned. The data were analyzed by using percentage, arithematic means, standard diviation and F-test.

Finding:

1. The opinions of instructors, graduates and intrepreneures concerning teaching and learning in furniture Design course were at the level of agreement in the aspects of curriculum and content, learning teaching activity, measurement and evaluation, expectant personality. But the usable knowledge were at the level of uncertainly.

2. When comparing the opinions of instructors, graduates and entrepreneurs concerning teaching and learning in Furniture Design course it was found that there were no significant differences at the 0.05.
