The objective of this research is to study the guideline to

preschool children's questions at the age of three to six years old, and this research also includes the study of guardian's answering quideline. The research is based on three target groups; guardians who give questions, specialists who screen the suitability of these questions, and guardians, who are satisfied with the answers. Four tools are used in this research; an interview form, the questionnaire No.1, the questionnaire No.2, and the questionnaire No.3. Data collecting from these tools will be used to find the percentage, and the percentage result from this calculation will then be used to build the guardian's answering guideline to preschool children.

Results:

- Guideline to preschool children's questions (age 3-6 years old)
 Questions which children ask their guardians divided into three groups; about themselves, about people surrounding them, and about their surrounding.
 - 1.2 Questions which children ask their guardians are divided into 3 types; looking for reasons, looking for truth, and looking for explanations which most asked.
- 2. Guideline to guardian's responses to preschool children's questions:
- 2.1 The principle which guardians used the most to response to questions is to response according to facts and to explain in details.
 - 2.2 Most of the expert agree to the guideline of guardian responses.

 Those who do not, have some difficulties with the questions about the children themselves of how they were born. In addition, the target populations (guardians) are satisfied with the guideline.
