Parole is one of the most crucial phases in the administration of criminal Justice. To day the parole process faces varieties of impediments and complication. Thailand parole falls within the responsibility of the Correction Department. The author finds that in order to ensure a successful application of the system, the deliberation making process in regard of a request for a parole should be decentralized; the prisoners themselves should be entitled to file a request for parole; the decision making process regarding the matter should be effectuated in a due process of law; the composition of the Parole Board should be improved so as to ensure independence and impartiality of the Board, an ideal Parole Board should comprise also experts from outside of the Correction Department, such as experts from other government agencies and private sectors.
