PRAPHA WICHIENSING: Efects of Verbal Stimulation on Language

Development of 3-5 year old children. Thesis Advisior: Mr. Aim

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The stimulation of verbal development in toddlers (3-5 years old) is an experimental research to study the comparative difference in terms of quality and quantity. The population, recruited through Simple Random Sampling Method, were 4 female and 3 male identical twins from 3 Bangkok Metropolitan day care centers: Public Health center 16, Public Health center 17 and Public Health center 19. The experimental group was stimulated through a 15-20 minutes' double telling of 5 tales for 10 times. The results of the pre and the post tests were then compared. The tool used was C.A.T. (Children's Apperception Test)

The results were :

- 1. A more complex sentence was mostly spoken by the experimental group.
- 2. There were significant differences in both quantity and quality in verbal development between the experimental group and the controlled group. The P. Values were 0.05.
