The purpose of this research is to study the principles and ideas of the repeated proceeding in the procedural laws of both Thai and Abroad to see how they are. In addition, this study tries to find the process of repeated proceeding of the civil procedure code, article 144 to see how it is accurate and whether it is possible to correct or not? and how?

The result of the research shows that the repeated proceeding in Thai laws is basically similar to that in English's procedure. After the decision is made, no one can bring that issue to the court again. It is finished because the procedure and decision of the court is final according to the principle of "res judicata". However, article 144 has some short-comings, particularly the lack of clearness of its content, which need to be reconsidered and improved.

At last, the conclusion of this research recommends several ways and means in order to enable the application of this repeated proceeding most effective, speedy and fair.
