

Sirirat Pornkhum 2008: Family Functioning, Self concept and Attitude toward Violent Behavior of the Students at a Technical College in Vocational Education Department, Bangkok. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Assistant Professor Tippawan Surinya, Ph.D. 141 pages.

The purposes of this research were 1) to study the level Attitude toward Violent Behavior Family Functioning and Self Concept of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok. 2) to stud Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok as compared by personal factors.3) to study the Relationship between Family Functioning and Self Concept and Attitude toward Violent Behavior of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok.4) to study the predictive variables of the Attitude toward Violent Behavior of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok.The sample were 327 Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok selected by stratified random sampling.The research instrument was the questionnaire developed by the researcher.The statistics were percentage,mean,standard deviation,t-test,F-test,Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient and Multiple Regression (Stepwise) analysis

The major finding were as follow: 1) the Attitude toward Violent Behaviors of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok were at moderate level. 2) Family Functioning such as Problem Solving, Communication, Roles, effective Responsiveness, Affective Involvement and Behavior Control of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok were at moderate level. 3) Self Concept such as Self-Ability, Emotional Adjustment, Interpersonal Relations and Self-Ideal of Technique Student's Vocational Education in Bangkok were at moderate level. 4) The Tecnique Student who were difference sex, difference age, difference graduate and difference marriage status of the parent had not difference Attitude toward Violent Behaviors. 5) Family Functioning such as Problem Solving, Communication, Roles, Affective Responsiveness, Affective Involvement and Behavior Control had related to Attitude toward Violent Behaviors at .01 level of significance.6) Self Concept such as Self-Ability,Emotional Adjustment, Interpersonal Relations and Self-Ideal had related to Attitude toward Violent Behaviors at .01 level of significance.7)The predictive variables of the Attitude toward Violent Behaviors were Problem Solving of Family Functioning, Self-Ability of Self Concept, Emotional Adjustment of Self Concept, Affective Involvement of Family Functioning, Interpersonal Relations of Self Concept, Communication of Family Functioning and Affective Responsiveness of Family Functioning,all of them were able to predict Attitude toward Violent Behaviors for 74.05 percent.
