The purpose of this research was to study effects of language activities upon creative thinking of Prathom Suksa four students.

The findings were as follows:

(1) After the experiment, the students' creative thinking was significantly higher than the research-referenced criterion 40 percent at the level of .05.

(2) After the experiment, the fluent thinking of students was significantly higher than the research-referenced criterion 40 percent at the level of .05. However, the flexibility and originality of thinking were not higher than the research-referenced criterion 40 percent at the level of .05.
