The purpose of the research is to study the nurse production policy of the Ministry of Public Health in the National Economic and Social Development Plans during the First to the Sixth.

It was found that the nurse production policy existed in the Health Development Policy of the National Economic and Social Development Plans, except in the First Plan (the first period) and in the Sixth National Plan. The policy statements were not directly indicated the production of nurses, but public health personnel, curative personnel or public health manpower instead. They were of Blessing Type policy.

The policies in the Fourth and the Fifth National Plan were rather clearly defined while the others indicated only objectives and goals of nurse production.
