KANGANA PONGHA : JOB SATISFACTION OF ART TEACHERS IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL EDUCATION, CENTRAL REGION. THESIS ADVISOR : DR. SULAK SRIBURI  
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The purposes of this study were to investigate the job satisfaction of art teachers in secondary schools under the jurisdiction of the Department of General Education located in Central Region of Thailand, and to compare job satisfaction of art teachers between art teachers in schools of municipal and sanitary area.

The population sample were the art teachers who were teaching in secondary schools under the Jurisdiction of the Department of General Education. The 195 questionnaires were sent to 65 schools in Central Region. The total of 166 questionnaires or 85 percent were returned. The statistical for data analysis were percentage, means, standard deviation. And t-test were used to compare the statistical significant difference of job satisfaction between those two groups of art teachers.

The results were as follow :

1. The factors of job satisfaction which rated by art teachers at the high level were orderly listed as followings: the nature of work, job security, job achievement, interpersonal relationship between administrators and peers, social status, succession in duty, policy and administration. And two factors of job satisfaction which rated at the little level were the working environment and salary and fring.

2. When the comparison of the statistical significant difference of job satisfaction at the level of .05 between art teachers in schools of municipal area and in sanitary area were conducted, it was found that there were satistical significant difference in the aspects of the nature of work, the salary and fring but there were no statistical significant difference in the other aspects.
