The purpose of this research was to study and compare the desirable characteristics of assistant administrators for business affairs in large secondary schools as expected by administrators and teachers in southern region. The study sample consisted of 167 administrators, and 309 teachers who were answered from all the 45 large secondary schools in southern region. The questionnaire form used in this research was divided according to the 2 qualifications of assistant administrators, namely; personal characteristics, and professional characteristics.

The results of the research indicated that the arithmetic mean of the desirable characteristics of assistant administrators for business affairs in both qualifications was within the range of which was considered to be at high level. In comparison of the expectation of administrators and teachers concerning personal characteristics, it was a significant difference at the .05 level. While the expectation of administrators and teachers concerning professional characteristics was no significant difference.
