The purposes of this study were: (1) to study the opinions of the practitioners of provincial non-formal education center concerning the humanistic adult education (2) to compare the opinions of the practitioners of provincial non-formal education centersaccording to ages, educational level, experience in teaching in formal school and non-formal education.

It was found that: 1. The majority of the practitioners of provincial non-formal education centers agreed with the humanistic adult education in the part concerning educational providing, and teaching - learning process at strongly agreed level; in humanistic basic concepts, educational purpose, knowledge, and evaluation at agreed level 2. The opinions of practitioners with different age and experience in teaching in non-formal education were not significance different. The opinions of practitioners with different educational level were significance different in the evaluation part. The opinions of practitioners with different experience in teaching in formal school were significance different in the part concerning knowledge.
