

VIRIYA GETMARO : THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN ANXIETY IN SPORT  
COMPETITION AND RESPONSIBILITY IN SPORT TRAINING OF ATHLETES IN THE  
EIGHTEENTH UNIVERSITY GAMES OF THAILAND B.E.2533. THESIS ADVISOR :  
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The purposes of this investigation were to study and to find the relationship between anxiety in sport competition and responsibility in sport training of athletes in the Eighteenth University Games of Thailand B.E. 2533. The 1000 samples were, coaches and athletes, randomized by multi-stages random sampling method. Martens' Sport Competition Anxiety Test (SCAT) and the Responsibility in Sport Training Inventory, constructed by the researcher, were utilized to collecting data. The data were analyzed in term of percentages, means, standard deviations and Pearson product moment correlation coefficient,  $r$ , by SPSS<sup>\*</sup>.

It was found that:

1. The anxiety in sport competition of athletes in the Eighteenth University Games of Thailand B.E. 2533 was at the moderate level.
2. The responsibility in sport training of athletes in the Eighteenth University Games of Thailand B.E. 2533 was at the high level.
3. The relationship between anxiety in sport competition and responsibility in sport training of athletes in the Eighteenth University Games of Thailand B.E. 2533 were not significantly correlated.
