

SOMPIT BUTRA : NEEDS FOR SUPERVISION IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION OF TEACHERS IN ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL PRIMARY EDUCATION COMMISSION, EDUCATIONAL REGION SEVEN. THESIS ADVISOR : PROF.DR. VORASAK PIENCHOB, P.E.D., 112 pp. ISBN 974-578-593-8

The purposes of this study were to investigate and to compare the needs for supervision between the trained and untrained physical education teachers in elementary schools under the jurisdiction of the Office of the National Primary Education Commission, Educational Region seven. Questionnaires were constructed and sent to 714 trained and untrained physical education teachers. Six hundred and eighty-five or 95.93 percent of questionnaires were returned. The obtained data were then analyzed in terms of percentages, means, standard deviation and t-test.

It was found that :

1. The trained and untrained physical education teachers of elementary schools under the jurisdiction of the Office of National Primary Education Commission, Educational Region seven needed for supervision and improvement in the areas of personality, curriculum and skills, teaching processes and teaching methods, producing and utilizing teaching materials, measuring and evaluating in physical education, and administering co-curricular activities at the "high" level.
2. When the needs of the trained and untrained physical education teachers were compared, it was found that there was no significant difference at the .05 level.
