

SUWAT KHATTIYABUTR : A STUDY OF JOB SATISFACTION OF OFFICIALS IN THE
OFFICE OF PROVINCIAL GENERAL EDUCATION IN THE NORTHEASTERN REGION.

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This research is aimed to study job satisfaction of officials in the Office of Provincial General Education in the northeastern region. The research is intended to study the degree of job satisfaction and the issues leading to job satisfaction ranging from the highest to the lowest degree, using the standardized Minnesota Satisfaction Questionnaire as its guideline, covering 20 issues: work competence work achievement, activities offered at work, promotion, authority and function of the job policy and work implementation, work compensation, creativity, freedom in performing tasks, morale principles in job performance, acceptance of job performance, responsibility, job stability, social service, social status, human relation with one's superior, one's superior's capability, job assignment, and work environment.

According to the research, it was found that the job satisfaction of officials in the Office of Provincial General Education in the northeastern region was at a satisfactory level, and that the issues ranked most satisfactory among these officials were work competence, social service, and work achievement, respectively. Those ranked least satisfactory were work compensation, job environment, and promotion, respectively.
