

PRIMPRAOW CHITPENTOM : KNOWLEDGE, ATTITUDE AND PRACTICE OF PRATHOM SUKSA SIX STUDENTS IN SCHOOLS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BANGKOK METROPOLITAN ADMINISTRATION CONCERNING ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION. THESIS ADVISOR : ASSO. PROF. PATCHARA KANCHANARANYA, 147 PP. ISBN 974-578-867-8

The purposes of the study were to investigate and to compare the knowledge, attitude, and practice of Prathom Suksa Six students in schools under the Jurisdiction of the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration concerning environmental pollution, The independent variables were sex and parents' education level.

The questionnaires constructed by the researcher were handed to 500 Prathom Suksa Six students, 250 boys and 250 girls, which were randomly selected as samples from primary schools. All or 100 percent of questionnaires were returned. The obtained data were then analyzed in terms of percentages, means and standard deviations. A t-test method was also applied to determine any significant differences.

The findings were as follows :

1. The knowledge of Prathom Suksa Six students concerning environmental pollution was in the good level. There were no statistical significant differences at the .05 level between 1) sexes 2) the students whose parents' education level below Mathayom Suksa and the students whose parents' education level equal or above Mathayom Suksa.

2. The students' attitude concerning environmental pollution was in the good level. Female students having higher level of attitude concerning environmental pollution than those of male students significantly at the .05 level. There was no statistical significant difference at the .05 level between The students whose parents' education level below Mathayom Suksa and the students whose parents' education equal or above Mathayom Suksa.

3. The students' practice concerning environmental pollution was in the good level. There were no statistical significant differences at the .05 level between 1) sexes 2) the students whose parents' education level below Mathayom Suksa and the students whose parents' education level equal or above Mathayom Suksa.
