

PRADIT TONGKAMPLEW : AN INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIP
BEHAVIOR OF ADMINISTRATORS IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS UNDER THE
JURISDICTION OF THE OFFICE OF NAKHON SI THAMMARAT

This research was designed to study an interpersonal relationship behavior of administrators in primary schools under the jurisdiction of The Office of Nakhon Si Thammarat Provincial Primary Education. Data was collected from sample group of population of administrators in primary schools. The instrument was a modified from Schutz's FIRO-B Questionnaire, consisted of 54 items in 3 behavioral characteristics, which were : inclusion, control and affection. The data was analyzed by using percentage, arithmetic means and standard deviation.

The finding of this study indicated that : the administrators in primary schools under the jurisdiction of The Office of Nakhon Si Thammarat Provincial Primary Education have high expressed inclusion, high expressed affection, medium wanted inclusion, medium expressed control, medium wanted control and medium wanted affection.
