

Suttinee Sakornvasee 2011: Work Motivation, Self-Efficacy, Social Support and Job Performance of Village Health Volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province. Master of Science (Community Psychology), Major Field: Community Psychology, Department of Psychology. Thesis Advisor: Associate Professor Buathong Sawangsopakul, M.S. 176 pages

The objectives of this research were as follows:- 1) to study work motivation, self-efficacy, social support and job performance of village health volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province; 2) to compare job performance of village health volunteers by personnel factors in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province; 3) to find out the correlation of work motivation, self-efficacy, social support and job performance of village health volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province. Samples used were 321 village health volunteers in Mueang district Nonthaburi Province. Data were collected by using questionnaires. Statistical methods used were percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, F-test, Multiple Comparison (LSD) and Pearson's Product Moment Correlation Coefficient. Statistical significant level were set at 0.01 and 0.05

The results of the study were as follows:- 1) Work motivation, self-Efficacy and job performance of the village health volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province were at moderate level, social support was at high level; 2) Village health volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province with differences in age and occupation had different job performance where as village health volunteers in Mueang District Nonthaburi Province with differences in sex, education, income, period being in village health volunteer and number of training had no differences in job performance 3) Positive correlation between work motivation, self-efficacy, social support had positive correlation to job performance of the volunteers was found at 0.01 level of significant.
