

Abstract

The study of "Access to Rehabilitation Service of the Disabled Capability after the Disabled Registration in particular the Comprehensive Disability Registration at Saraburi Hospital" with an objection to study about the access to capable rehabilitation, their difficulties and their demand to receive the government and private sector's service, subsequent to the disabled's registration. It is studied by researching the sample groups of the disabled, who have registered at Comprehensive Disability Registration of Saraburi Hospital Service Center for 278 cases. The analysis consists of equipping the percentage, the average, the deviation, t-test and F-test at the level of significance statistically at 0.05. Following is outcome of the study.

Most of the disabled are female, whose ages are ranging between age 21-30 years old, unmarried with elementary education and making their living as employees. The average income is 3,736 baht per month. They are classified into category of distinguished physical disability. The access to capable rehabilitation service is overviewed at moderate level. The sample groups can access to social services which being provided with facilities. The problems and obstacles are assessed at medium level. The problems can be identified as one's own problems rather than the family problems, as they cannot afford transportation fees. It's found out that their needs to receive the services from government and private sector are very high. The sample groups desire to be offered more facilities in service center and various welfares for the disabled. From the result of analysis of the variation to compare the difference between the access to capable rehabilitation center and general information, it shows that the difference in occupation, income, types of disability will affect the access to capable rehabilitation service. Moreover, the difference in age, education level, occupation, income, different types of disability will result in difference of problems and obstacles in accessing to capable rehabilitation service. And the difference in educational level, occupation, income, types of disability will result in difference in demand for government and private sector's service and its information.

Recommendations The disabled should be provided more facilities, physical disability supporting equipments. Their transportation fees should be subsidized. They should be offered employment opportunity by entrepreneurs. There should be counselors to give them advice as well as information media about various agencies. There also should be the solution of disability to enable them to access to the service by themselves for their well being.
