

Thesis Title	Problems in Implementation of Student Affairs in Northeastern and Northern Technical Colleges
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ABSTRACT

The purposes of this research were : 1) to study the job performance problems in the student offairs management of Technical Colleges. The work performance was based on the 1986 Vacational Department regulation of school administration 2) to compare the job performance problems in the student offairs management of Technical College varies with the job positions. This research leaded to the performance development of the student affairs management of Technical Colleges varies with the job positions. Department of Vocational Education.

The population under study consisted of 33 assistant directors responded of student offairs management and 165 heads job division in student affairs management of the Technical Colleges throughout the north and the northeast

The Instrument used in this study was the questionnaire constructed by the researcher. The questionnaire was covered the parts of student career guidance services, student activities, student discipline, special project, and student welfare health services according to the 1986 Vocational Department Regulation of school administration. The first part consisted of the informants' information. The second was comprised of the job performance problems in the student affairs management as the rating scales and the third on was the informants' opinion in order to state other problems. Of the 198 questionnaires sent out, the number of returned responses were 186 (93.94 %)

The collected data were analyzed by the applications of percentage, means and Standard Deviation; The findings were as follows.

1. The job performance problems in the student affairs management of technical colleges totally were in the medium affairs All the job performance problems classified with the job aspects were also in the medium level.

2. This research found that the assistant directors' job performance problems in each type of jobs compared with the heads of job divisions responded to, showed no difference in student activities. But it showed difference in student career guidance services, student discipline, student welfare & health services and special project.

In conclusion, the job performance problems in the student affair management of technical colleges were in the medium level.
