The purposes of this research are: (1) to study the administrators' opinions on existing condition and problems of the MIS; (2) to compare the administrators' opinions on existing condition and their expectation of the MIS for the administration of the office of the teacher civil service commission (OTCSC).

The findings are follows:

1. The objective of the existing condition concerning MIS of the OTCSC is to collect data utilized for planning and formulating the policy of the administration which have only one information center whose responsibilities are to collect, store, process and present data for use. Measured against this objective, it was found that the operation concerning these responsibilities is at a moderate level.

The problems faced in the past of the OTCSC were at a high level. These include a lack of personnel and administrative resources. The personnel themselves are incompetent and overworked.

2. Based on the administrators' expectation on the present condition of the MIS arrangement, most of the administrators agree that the OTCSC should clearly and systematically formulate policy and objective on the utilization, system, development, definition, and classification of the MIS, including the set up of a specific unit responsible for the MIS. The administrators differs of two major points, however.. These include the policy and objective of the OTCSC on MIS system arrangement and development as well as selectivity in data collection necessary for utilization.
