

MAYUREE KLUBWONG : MEMORY TRAINING PRACTICE IN IMPAIRED MEMORY

The purposes of this study are to establish a new device for memory training in impaired memory Thai elderly, and also to evaluate the effectiveness of this device by Solomon four group design. Forty impaired memory elderly were sampled by random assignment method.

The device was adjusted for Thai people from Stengel method. Mini Mental State Exam was used as pretest and posttest. The experimental group show significant improvement in memory at $p < .01$ as compare to control group. The result of this study was controlled and tested. Pretest was shown to have not any effect on posttest.

Two-way analysis of variance was used. Age x sex, education x sex, marital status x sex were tested. Impaired memory elderly aged 60-75, both sexes, any educational level, past occupation or marital status can all benefit from this training program.
