

## Abstract

The study on “The Evaluation of recovery and development ability of the homeless people to protect against the deception : case study Chomphra district and Thatoom district, Surin province” has the purposes to study about the effectiveness of training knowledge divided into knowledge for career, knowledge for funding collection for career and knowledge for connecting with authorities, the effectiveness of career, and the effectiveness of income. This study is summative evaluation which the researcher use mixed-methodology to study with 100 members. The findings are as follows; most of the members themselves participated in training knowledge when the officers went to there. They chose representative to connect the authorities, and they has the officers to take care the activities in their groups, for example finding the market and giving suggestion to make careers. Most of the members exchanged their knowledge by talking and meeting. They mostly got knowledge to make the careers, to collect the fund for career, and to connect with the authorities. For the effectiveness of career, all of the members have careers. Most of them make them in the native, and they make other careers, too. For the effectiveness of income, after participating in the project, they got more income. Their debt is reduced, but they have to spent much money for their family. Some of them spent the income from their selling the production to buy the equipment for careers, they lend and spent money in their group instead of lending debt out of system.

The study has found the problems about insufficient fund for career, income, and land to make careers. Some of them felt unstable, and they wanted to keep training knowledge in career project again.

The study has recommendation that the authorities enthusiastically have to take care the members about careers and market to buy their production. The authorities have to let the member to see other training careers for adding their career knowledge.
