

CHOATHIP BUNYANAN : A COMPARISON OF LIFE SATISFACTION BETWEEN

The objective of this thesis was to compare the life satisfaction between teachers with and without pre-retirement preparation according to sex, age, marital status, education, incomes and health.

The 319 subjects were randomly drawn from pre-retirement teachers in school under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of the Education. The data was collected by pre-retirement preparation questionnaires, composed by the researcher, and Neugarten's life satisfaction questionnaires.

The results are as follows : 1) Pre-retirement preparation has positive relationship with life satisfaction 2) Life satisfaction of teachers with pre-retirement preparation are higher than the ones without pre-retirement preparation. 3) Life satisfaction scores of the healthy persons are significantly higher than unhealthy persons. 4) There is no significantly different in life satisfaction scores according to sex, age, marital status, education and incomes. 5) There is a significantly different in life satisfaction according to the interaction between pre-retirement preparation levels and others independent variables as sex, education and marital status.
