

ABSTRACT

The persons with disabilities are persons who have physical or mental deficiency which handicap their livelihood and social participation. In Thailand, there is no convention to efficiently protect or support persons with disabilities. They have been taken advantage in many ways; employment, political expression or education opportunity, for example. These problems should be aware of and given great attention to. There should be convention on the rights of persons with disabilities substantially in Thailand. This was why Thailand became the member of Convention on The Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2006, which directly aims to protect and covers the rights of persons with disabilities efficiently and substantially. This convention is not the first enacted to protect and support the rights of persons with disabilities, but it is the one which directly and substantially aims at the rights of persons with disabilities' protection. The state members of convention have to enact measures and obligations to correspond with the intention of convention on the rights of persons with disabilities and to ensure that it is the provision of law to efficiently protect the rights of persons with disabilities. This cooperation is to stimulate and confirm international cooperation of countries in protection of the rights of persons with disabilities.

The intention of thesis is to study the sources, objectives, and measures of the Convention on The Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2006, how it enacts to protect and support human rights of persons with disabilities and how it obligates Thailand as a member of party state. Moreover, it is to study if there is any domestic law in Thailand compatible with this convention, or deprive of the rights of persons with disabilities. It is also to distribute knowledge of the rights of persons with disabilities to people in order to realize how importance they are to the society and to respect their prestige. The research was from textbooks, research reports, articles, e-learning and the experts in the rights of persons with disabilities. Thesis focuses on how persons with disabilities facing the real problems in the society and how those problems could be solved relevantly. It is also to analyze how international law and domestic law relevant to the rights of persons with disabilities and how to protect deprivation of law in that rights.
