

## **ABSTRACT**

This study examined the attitudes of students at Benchamatheputit Phetchaburi School towards studying on the English Program or E.P. The study also investigated and compared attitudes towards the English Program among M.1, M.2 and M.3 students to find out whether they were different or not. The samples in this study were the English program students who were studying at Benchamatheputit Phetchaburi School, in the academic year of 2007, totally 147 students. The research was a cross-sectional survey. The instrument used in this research was a questionnaire consisting of 2 parts: demographic information and attitudes of students towards studying on the English Program. The data was analyzed by means of Frequency and Percentage, Arithmetic Means and Standard Deviations. The main findings of the study were that most of the students in M.1, M.2 and M.3 had a high level of attitude towards studying on the English Program. However, there should be some improvement recommended such as more variety of subjects for students to select, more interesting and up-to-date textbooks and an adjustment in teaching styles, etc.
