Nuttakul Thongkaewpaiboon 2014: Gender Role, Communication Between, Spouses, Parenting Self-Efficacy and Marital Quality of Employees at Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (Sirikit Dam) in Uttaradit Province. The purposes of this research were 1) to study the Gender role, Communication between spouses, Parenting Self-efficacy and Marital quality of the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand employees. (Sirikit Dam) Uttaradit province. 2) To employees and marital quality which personal factors are different. 3) To compare employees and marital quality which different gender roles. 4) To study the relationship of communication between spouses. 5) To study Parenting Self-efficacy and marital quality employees. Samples used in research are 162 employees of Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (Sirikit dam) Uttaradit province. Collecting data by using set of questionnaires and analyzed the data by a SPSS program. The data analyzed are percent average, standard deviation, t-test, F-test (one-way variance), A comparison of pairs by LSD method, and the correlation coefficient of Pearson is used.

The results of the study were as follows: 1) gender role, communication between spouses, parenting self-efficacy and marital quality at all high level.; 2) employees at electricity generating authority of thailand (sirikit dam) who had different in sex, income, level of job and number of children condition have different in marital quality.; 3) communication between spouses had positive correlation with marital quality with statistically significant at .001 and 4) parenting self-efficacy had positive correlation with marital quality with statistically significant at .001
